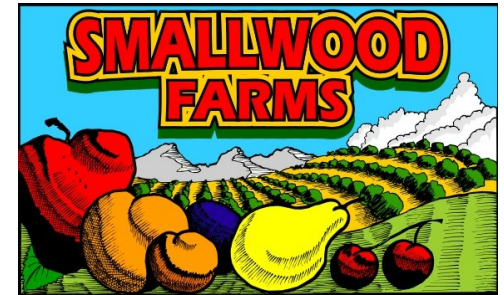

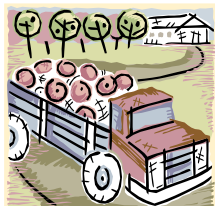

our CSA is that we offer mainly fruit. Throughout

the 16 weeks you will receive some vegetables such

as snow peas, onions, green beans, squash but you

will always have a basket full of fresh, delicious

fruit! The baskets are different each week depending

on what is fresh, that's what the CSA is all

about! We also provide an email newsletter to tell

you about what you receive in your basket. All the

fruit and produce provided in your weekly basket

is grown organically. Our goal each year is to grow

quality, flavorful fruit and produce that not only we

enjoy, but our customers enjoy too!

## What is CSA?

CSA stands for Community Supported Agriculture. It is a way to connect the consumers directly to the farmer. Since you pay for your share up front, you are also helping the farming with some of the costs of growing the wonderful fruit and produce that you will receive in your weekly basket. By becoming a CSA member you are not only supporting your local farmer, you can have the confidence of saying that you know where your food comes from!

## When is CSA Pick Up?

The CSA will begin every **Thursday** starting:

**July 1st - October 14th**

### Pick Up Times and Locations

**Twisp/Winthrop:** 5-7pm at Winthrop Physical Therapy

**Omak/Okanogan:** 3-6pm at Smallwood Farms Fruit Stand in Okanogan

## What if I am Going to Be Gone or Miss a Pick Up?

If you know you are going to be gone you can take the following action:

- Please let us know at least **48 hours** in advance, if possible. It takes a lot of time and preparation to put the baskets together so we appreciate the heads up.
- You can have a friend pick up your basket for you, just send us an email or give us a call so we know that someone else is picking up for you.
- You can double up your share the week before you are gone (if you know in advance) or you can double your share the following week you return.
